This annual regatta, started in the 1960’s by Bill Sloman, as an event where every boat owning club member would get a chance to sail all at the same time and everyone would have a chance to finish first with the bulk of the fleet finishing nearly at the same time. It’s a “pursuit” start, so everyone gets an assigned starting time in minutes and seconds after the starting signal. Slower rated boats start first and the faster boats wait till last for their start. **KNOW** your starting time. All start times will be posted on the bulletin board inside the clubhouse.
