NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 North Star Junior Sailing will provide its fleet of C420's for racing.
- 1.3 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at North Star Sail Club.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all sailors.
- 2.2 Eligible teams of two or individual sailors may enter by email to Nikolaus Kowal-Besler at nkowalbe@gmail.com by 1700 on 9/20/2019.
- 2.3 Individually registered sailors will be paired into two person teams at random.
- 2.4 Late entries will be subjected to \$10.00 late fee.
- 2.5 Entry numbers will not be limited however, if greater than seven teams, entries will be divided into two divisions and will sail in a round robin fashion.

3 CLASSIFICATION

Division splits will be at the discretion of the race committee if necessary.

4 FEES

- 4.1 Required fees will be \$30.00 per person.
- 4.2 Other fees: late entries may be subject to late fees as outlined above.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Skippers meeting and equipment inspection will be scheduled for 0900.
- 5.2 Dates of racing: September 22, 2019
- 5.3 Number of races: no limit will be set on max or minimum number of races.
- 5.4 The scheduled harbor start will be 1000, lunch on the water will be provided.
- 5.5 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1500.
- 5.6 Award ceremony will follow racing, dinner will be available at NSSC, all proceeds will benefit North Star Junior Sailing.

6 MEASUREMENT

Boats will be supplied by the organizing body and are to be compliant with collegiate 420 class rules.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 2100 on 9/20/2019.

8 VENUE

8.1 North Star Sail Club (NSSC) will be the host venue.

9 THE COURSES

Windward- leeward courses will be sailed, leaving marks to port with windward finishes. Further information will be found in the Sailing Instructions

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 The Scoring Penalty, RRS 44.3, will apply.

10.2 Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

11 SCORING

11.1 (a) When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from five to ten races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When ten or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

12 PRIZES

Prizes will be given for top three scoring boats in all divisions.

13 DISCLAIMERS OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
